Fern Creek/Highview United Ministries, Inc. (FCHUM) is a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) social service agency founded in 1988 by 10 local church congregations. In its 23<sup>rd</sup> year, FCHUM is supported in part by 22 churches representing 12 denominations working together to make a difference in the community. Funding is also received from KIPDA (the Area Agency for Aging) on behalf of the Kentucky Cabinet for Health & Family Services, the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, and Louisville Jefferson County Metro Government.

The purpose of FCHUM is to provide a social services ministry for the Fern Creek and Highview areas of Louisville Metro improving the quality of life of the community.

FCHUM programs include, but are not limited to, the Individual & Family Assistance Center (IFAC), the Adult Day Center (ADC), Families In Transition (FIT), Meals On Wheels (MOW), and the Health Equipment Loan Program (HELP).
